To co-lead a final project evaluation (against agreed indicators) for an integrated maternal health project in the Zomba district of Malawi as part of a comprehensive Monitoring and Evaluation Framework.

Introduction and Background:

Maternity Worldwide (www.maternityworldwide.org) is an international non-governmental organisation which exists to help reduce the number of women dying or injured in childbirth. Our vision is of a world in which all women and their babies are able to access safe and appropriate childbirth regardless of where they live. We are the UK's leading charity dedicated to saving lives in childbirth overseas.

Maternity Worldwide (MW) uses an integrated approach following the 'Three Delays Model' delivering both demand and supply side interventions.

An integrated maternal and newborn health project has been implemented in (TAs), Mwambo and Chikowi, of Zomba district by the Catholic Health Commission (CHC); Maternity Worldwide and Zomba District Health Office. The project has been fully funded by the Big Lottery Fund (BIG) and is in its final quarter of operation.

Project Aim:

To increase access to high quality maternal health services in the Zomba district of Malawi and thereby reduce the unacceptably high levels of maternal and neonatal mortality and morbidity.
