UPDATE ON FIRE INCIDENT AT ADMARC LILONGWE DEPOT

ADMARC wishes to inform the general public that it had a fire incident at its **Lilongwe Depot** on **Saturday 9th September 2023** at around **10:49 am**.

The fire erupted between Shed 4 and the kitchen on an open space where unserviceable sacks, chaff and mini silo tarpaulins which had been boarded off, by the Internal Asset Disposal Committee, and were being kept awaiting safe disposal.

The Police and Fire Department rushed to the scene and managed to put out the fire around 2pm before it had caused any damage to the warehouses or any buildings at the Depot.

The cause of the fire is still being investigated and we wish to assure the public that the company has not lost any valuable items in this fire. We are collaborating with relevant government departments and our Internal Audit team to determine what exactly happened for the fire to erupt within the ADMARC premises.

ADMARC Management would sincerely like to render their appreciation to the Police Service and Lilongwe City Fire Department, for handling the situation professionally and with promptness.
